



### Second Sunday in Ordinary Time - 15th January 2023

Dear Parishioners.

Welcome to the Ordinary Season in the Church's liturgical calendar. The 1st part of this season will run for 7 weeks leading to Ash Wednesday which is on the 22nd of February this year. This season offers us the opportunity to appreciate the extraordinary



that Jesus is the Lamb of God who (does not condemn but) takes away the sins of the world. As beneficiaries of the mercy of God, let us also be the joyful messengers of God's truth.

In Evangelii Gaudium, Pope Francis teaches that the Gospel constantly invites us to rejoice. This is because the whole of Jesus' ministry is to bring his joy to world. There was joy at his birth and great rejoicing at his resurrection. Pope Francis believes that in a world marked by hardship and pain, Christians should embark upon a new chapter of evangelization marked by joy. For us here as a parish and for you as a parishioner, let the spreading and sharing of the joy of the Gospel be our way of life through the year.

The world and the church in particular has experienced the death of some significant personalities in the last few weeks. I identified two things in all the recent deaths such as the iconic Pelé, Pope Benedict XVI, Cardinal Pell, Josephine Russo and Ernesto Palombo. No matter how fully we live our lives, death cuts it short. Death reminds us of the shortness of our life and challenges us to live for posterity. May the faithful departed rest in peace and those who grieve at their passing find consolation in the joy of the Gospel.

I began my ministry in Australia in 2018 at the peak of George Cardinal Pell's legal battles. As a priest of the 21st century, I was amazed by the fact that the highest-ranking Australian Catholic clergy at the time came down from Rome to Australia in order to face the law. That was for me an example of the equality of everyone before the law and a reminder for everyone to respect the law. It also highlighted the seriousness of the crime of child sexual abuse and its social consequences. In a tribute to Cardinal Pell, Archbishop Mark Coleridge rightly identifies Cardinal Pell as a "Man of faith and a man of the Church" who would want to be remembered as a man who vehemently loved the Lord and the Church. No wonder it seemed that the Catholic Church in Australia was standing trial during Cardinal Pell's legal battle. As we pray for the repose of his soul, may our Church be renew in the Love of the Lord and the power of the Holy Spirit. Amen.
