Third Sunday in Ordinary Time - 22nd January 2023

Dear Parishioners.

In the Gospel of this 3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time, we have Jesus starting his mission and calling the first disciples.

The baptism of Jesus by John the Baptist is the inaugural act of his mission. Attracted by the John's message, **Jesus abandons his routine life in Nazareth in Galilee**, seeks baptism through John in the region beyond the Jordan and begins to form his own discipleship and mission.

John the Baptist announced **conversion to the practice of righteousness as the way to remove the sin of the world.** With his invitation to baptism and conversion, he triggered a discipleship process in which Jesus, who came from Galilee, was introduced.

What characterizes discipleship is conversion. Just as Jesus, after receiving baptism from John, abandoned his usual family way of life in Nazareth, so too the disciples abandoned their professional activities and the usual socializing with their families and colleague to follow Jesus.

Conversion takes place by looking at Jesus and allowing oneself to be touched by his merciful love and by his words. Thus, we are freeing ourselves from the ideologies of success, wealth and power, to incorporate values of communion with others, in meekness and affection, building a new world order where the principles of justice and fraternity will prevail.

This weekend, my invitation to all of us is to discern the call of Jesus in our daily lives. Every day, Jesus is present in our lives and calls us to follow him. Let us pray for all vocations: those called to religious and priestly life, those called to married and family life, and to all the many singles in our parish community to listen and respond to God's call to service.

The feast day for Our Lady of Lourdes will be on Saturday 11 February. This year, there will a Parish Expo as part of the celebrations across the weekend of 11 & 12 February. The Parish Expo is intended to showcase all our parish groups, associations and activities in order to enliven the Sunnybank Popular piety and participation. It will be an opportunity for everyone to find out what's happening in the parish, ask questions and consider how to be part of the 2023 Parish themed "Be inspired, renewed and strengthen our parish."

It is Lunar New Year on 22 January and so we would like to wish all our parishioners of oriental heritage a happy Lunar New Year. Lunar New Year is traditionally celebrated in Asian countries especially in China and others influenced by Chinese culture like Vietnam, South Korea, Singapore, Malaysia, Thailand, Japan, Philippines, and Indonesia. This year it is the year of the Rabbit . The Rabbit is a symbol of longevity, peace, and prosperity in Chinese culture; may this sign bring us blessings this year.

146. In this sense, it is essential to show special care for indigenous communities and their cultural traditions. They are not merely one minority among others, but should be the principal dialogue partners, especially when large projects affecting their land are proposed. For them, land is not a commodity but rather a gift from God and from their ancestors who rest there, a sacred space with which they need to interact if they are to maintain their identity and values. When they remain on their land, they themselves care for it best. Nevertheless, in various parts of the world, pressure is being put on them to abandon their homelands to make room for agricultural or mining projects which are undertaken without regard for the degradation of nature and culture.


