Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time - 29th January 2023

Dear Parishioners.

Last weekend we heard that two of the most humbled towns in the Old Testament, Zebulun and Naphtali were exalted because they became the regions where Jesus Christ started his earthly ministry. This weekend we will be listening to one of the least known Old Testament



prophets; Zephaniah. While Zephaniah will be urging us to obey God's commands, seek integrity and humility, the Gospel of Matthew will be inviting us to follow the way of the Beatitude. Reflecting on the beatitude, the Catechism of the Catholic Church identifies Jesus as the model for the beatitudes. Therefore, to achieve the beatitude, we have to follow Jesus who humbled himself in poverty, gentility, forbearance, quest for justice and peace, and in holiness of life. Let us thank God who trusts that we can share in the Divine Blessedness and ask for the grace to follow Jesus our example and model.

Next week, the Church in Australia will celebrate **Word of God Sunday on February 5** 2023 (Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year A). Pope Francis established the day, which is devoted to "the celebration, study and dissemination" of the Word of God. One of the primary ways in which we honour God's Word in the liturgy is by faithfully listening to the proclamation of the readings and the homily, and by discerning the various ways in which God's Word applies to our lives. There are also some other ways of celebrating the Word in groups (Bible Study and Christian Meditation) and in private by daily reading and reflecting of the Scripture.

After the holidays, some parish activities that were in recess are gradually resuming. I thank the leadership of the various parish groups and welcome you to another year of Pastoral, Spiritual and Missionary activities. As we approach the Parish Feast day weekend, I encourage everyone to engage our parish life beyond weekend attendance to belonging to at least one parish group. It is my wish that through the Parish Expo, you will find a group that will need you as well as support your daily Christian living.

Next Friday is our First Friday and Saturday is Men's Breakfast. One way of engaging our parish life beyond weekends is our monthly First Friday Mass at 10.00am and wonderful morning tea. All parishioners are cordially invited to attend this Mass in the Church followed by Morning Tea in the Avocado Room.

It is said that time flies when you are having fun and it seems unreal that we have come to the end of January 2023. This is a reminder for everyone to gear up for a very amazing year and I pray that you will ahead of every time this year.

WORLD DAY FOR CONSECRATED LIFE - 2nd February 2023

First Reading: Zephaniah 2:3, 3:12–13 Some during the history of Israel tended to equate material prosperity with divine blessing. Zephaniah's words point in a different direction. It is those who are humble and seek their refuge in the Lord who receive divine blessing. It is the lowly and the poor who set their eyes to God who are truly blessed.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 1:26–31 Paul speaks of the limitation of human wisdom as God chooses what we assume is insignificant to show the true glory of God. It is a reminder that we have nothing to boast for on our own accord. All that is worthwhile truly comes from God.

Gospel: Matthew 5:1–12 The Beatitudes present a collection of ways that we can live the blessings of God. Those who humbly seek the will of God will be assured of lasting happiness.

III. ECOLOGY IN DAILY LIFE

Welcome back and Happy New Year to everyone! We invite men of all ages to come together in fellowship and enjoy




a full barbeque breakfast on the first Saturday morning of each month.


