Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time - 19th February 2023

Dear Holy Parishioners,

Yes! I call you holy because **holiness is our calling and it should be our mission in the world**. The Second Vatican Council teaches that all who believe in Jesus Christ regardless of their vocation in life are called to holiness. **God created us in his image and likeness, and most of us**



will easily accept holiness as one of the major attributes of God. Hence, we are and should remain what God has created us to be "Holy Humanity". This concept of a "Holy Humanity" reflected through all God's covenant with Israel and with us.

Leviticus 19:2 calls Israel to be holy for their God is holy, while Jesus calls us to be perfect for our father is perfect. Therefore, scripture suggests that we can live out our humanity in holiness and I think that an authentic "Holy Humanity" is attractive not repulsive, beautiful and not scary. As we approach the start of the season of Lent, let the universal call to holiness be our watchword even as we pray, fast and practise almsgiving.

I equally acknowledge the commitment of the various Parish Group leaders in putting up a beautiful Parish Expo last weekend. We are happy with the feedback from those who participated in the last weekend's Parish Expo. Our Parish Pastoral Council would like to hear your suggestions too.

All the Children who will be going through the First Rite of the Sacrament of Reconciliation are invited to their Enrolment Mass next weekend. The parish is asked to pray for these children and their families, as they continue their Sacramental journey with us.

First Reading: Leviticus 19:1–2, 17–18 The text from Leviticus prefigures the teachings of Jesus – how we treat our brothers and sisters is fundamental to the whole Law.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 3:16–23 The repeated theme that we have heard from Corinthians in recent weeks continues; God's wisdom far supersedes human wisdom. This week, Paul focusses on how we are called to unity in such wisdom. Being a family that belongs to Christ is the only source of self-importance that matters.

Gospel: Matthew 5:38-48 The first chapter of the Sermon on the Mount finishes with a call to a life mirroring the perfection of God.



Bruce Downes and the Catholic Guy team present an all new Parish Mission Event with 4 inspiring and life changing sessions for people of all ages that you just have to experience!


Experience the power of God in real and relevant way through scripture, music and the arts. Expect to laugh, learn, reflect and be changed by this truly powerful Catholic experience.


DATE CHANGE: ANOINTING MASS & MORNING TEA


