Easter Sunday of the Resurrection - 9th April 2023

Dear Parishioners, Friends and Visitors,

Happy Easter to you all. Thank you for choosing to celebrate New Life and the promise of Resurrection in Jesus Christ the Risen Saviour in our parish. To our parishioners especially, we have been inviting our friends to share our life of faith with us during this



holy season, let us now pray that they may have awesome experiences of the radiance of the light of the Risen Savour in our community. I would like to thank Fr Francisco, Noel, Barbara, the Liturgy Committee, the Choir, the Youth and all our volunteers who were so much committed to making the celebrations of our Palm Sunday, Sacred Paschal Triduum and Easter special and glorious. Your dedication to our parish especially this time is very encouraging and affirming. To all those who made generous donations to the Project Compassion, The Holy Land and to us, may God bless your goodwill.

The Archdiocesan Communication Office has informed us that the ABC TV crew may be coming to film our Good Friday Celebration of the Lord's Passion. Friday of the Passion of the Lord (Year A)

First Reading: Isaiah 52:13-53:12 The servant grew up amongst the people, was innocent and completely dedicated to the will of God.

Second Reading: Hebrews 4:14-16, 5:7-9 As priest Jesus hears our petitions and as human understands our needs. As one with God, he brings our prayers to God without fail and with mercy

Gospel: John 18:1-19:42 Jesus undergoes death but is not controlled by it. The stripping away at the crucifixion is the revelation of his identity.

Easter Sunday of the Resurrection (Year A)

First Reading: Acts 10:34, 37-43 Peter proclaims the gospel of Jesus' life, death and resurrection but this time he also proclaims it to non-Jews. It is to be proclaimed to all the world.

Second Reading: Colossians 3:1-4 Christians are called to look to heavenly things and to know that our life in him is hidden for now but will be revealed when Christ is fully revealed.

Gospel: John 20:1-9 Mary Magdalene runs to tell Peter and the Beloved Disciple that the tomb is empty.

OF THE HOLY FATHER FRANCIS ON CARE FOR OUR COMMON HOME

What is Happening to our Common Home

CHAPTER FOUR: INTEGRAL ECOLOGY

IIV. THE PRINCIPLE OF THE COMMON GOOD

157. Underlying the principle of the common good is respect for the human person as such, endowed with basic and inalienable rights ordered to his or her integral development. It has also to do with the overall welfare of society and the development of a variety of intermediate groups, applying the principle of subsidiarity. Outstanding among those groups is the family, as the basic cell of society. Finally, the common good calls for social peace, the stability and security provided by a certain order which cannot be achieved without particular concern for distributive justice; whenever this is violated, violence always ensues. Society as a whole, and the state in particular, are obliged to defend and promote the common good.
