

The Ascension of the Lord - 21st May 2023

Dear parishioners,

This Sunday, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Ascension of the **Lord to Heaven**. It is the mystery of faith that the Acts of the Apostles places forty days after the resurrection, during which Jesus spoke to the disciples and taught them about the life of unity with God. Jesus, after having presented his Father's project to the world, entered into the definitive life of communion with God, the same life that awaits all those who walk the same "path" that Jesus walked.

The Christ's earthly mission ends and that of his disciples begins. They cannot remain looking at the sky, but they need to go among the people in order to continue the mission that Jesus entrusted to them. And Jesus himself promises to remain with them invisibly but really and effectively until the end of time.

Now our mission is to sanctify the world and, for this, Christ will always be with us. It is the promise that he himself left: "Behold, I will be with you always, until the end of the world". His presence in the Church is a new, invisible but real presence. Jesus is still alive and active in the Christian community; where two or more gather in his name. Christ continues to be present among us through faith, through the Word, through the Sacraments, especially through the Most Holy Eucharist.

Next Sunday we will celebrate the manifestation of the Holy Spirit in the miracle of Pentecost in the Upper Room where we find Mary, the Mother of Jesus and his Apostles gathered in prayer, when they were filled with the Holy Spirit. I encourage you in these seven days before Pentecost, to invoke the impartation and the unction of the Spirit of the living God.

This year our church will gather to celebrate our 10th annual Multicultural Mass. The Multicultural Weekend calls all our parishioners from all the different nationalities that make up our community, to come together "To praise God with the Cultural Diversity of our Parish and to show our Unity in Christ". We are so blessed with the gifts that we all are and bring to our community. You are invited to come along with your family and friends, with fellow parishioners, enjoy the rich diversity, different languages and different cultures. Save the date: Saturday 17th June 6pm Mass, Sunday 18th June 10:30am Mass & 6pm Youth Mass. At the Masses, you are encouraged to show your national origins and culture, also to share as Australians and as Multicultural people by wearing your national dress or cultural clothing.

Do you know that it is your call to nominate those who will serve as our Parish Pastoral Council members? Pastoral Council Nomination Forms will be available and you can nominate parishioners who will join the Parish Pastoral Council. I would also encourage you to pray for all our parish leaders and volunteers.

From May 21 to 28, people around the world will come together to celebrate Laudato Si' Week 2023, a commemoration dedicated to reflecting and acting upon the message of Pope Francis' encyclical on the environment, Laudato Si'. This year's theme, "Hope for the Earth". Thanks be to God for the ecological consciousness that Laudato Si' brought to the world.

The Ascension of the Lord (Year A)

First Reading: Acts 1:1-11 The Acts of the Apostles opens with Jesus' final instructions; be ready to receive the Holy Spirit which empowers you to witness Christ to the whole world.

Second Reading: Ephesians 1:17-23 The reading from Ephesians attests that Christ, through his descending into death and ascension into heaven, has supreme sovereignty over all creation. Through faith and love, we come to experience this truth and find our place in Christ.

Gospel: Matthew 28:16-20 The final scene in Matthew's gospel focusses less on Jesus' departing and more on instructions for Christ's followers. They are to go to 'all the nations' and draw people into Christ.

CHAPTER FIVE: LINES OF APPROACH AND ACTION

We invite men of all ages to come together in fellowship and enjoy a full BBQ breakfast on the first Saturday morning of each month.


