# The Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) - 11th June 2023

Dear Parishioners,

The Solemnity of the Corpus et Sanguis Christi is our celebration and profession of our faith in the real presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. During Benediction, one of the Divine Praises is "Blessed be Jesus in the Most Holy Sacrament of the Altar". St Paul so



beautifully presents this teaching in 1 Cor. 10: 16-17 "The blessing-cup that we bless is a communion with the blood of Christ, and the bread that we break is a communion with the body of Christ." No wonder Vatican II declares that the Eucharist is the "Source and Summit of the Christian life." We can relate to the Divine will and truth of the Eucharistic teaching of John 6:53 "Truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of man and drink his blood, you have no life in you." It is a privilege to share and to be the Eucharist in our world that is broken, and hungers for Jesus. The Eucharist is our vocation in the sense that we are called to be the real presence of Jesus to the ends of the earth.

I would like to thank all our Extraordinary Ministers of the Holy Communion who serve as the immediate and material agents of the encounter between Jesus and His people at Communion in the Church, Hospitals, Nursing Homes, and private homes. I welcome our 2023 First Holy Communion Candidates who will be formally enrolled into the Sacramental Program for the Eucharist.

Let us keep our ALPHA team in our prayers as they participate in the Holy Spirit Retreat this weekend. We thank the leadership and facilitators of Alpha in our Parish and pray that they may beinspired by the fruits of all their efforts. If you missed this round of ALPHA, hang on there will be another round by September/October.

All is now set for the **St Vincent De Paul Community Sleep out (16 June)** and I am excited to join this campaign, challenge my sense of empathy, feel what it means to be on the other side and to offer a helping hand. **Thanks to all who donated to this cause.**

# The Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) (Year A)

**First Reading: Deuteronomy 8:2-3, 14-16** The passage from Deuteronomy reminds the people of God that the Lord cares for them. They are encouraged to remember that God provided for them in their time of need and did so in new ways, for God gave them food that their ancestors did not know

**Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 10:16-17** Though we are many, we are formed into one body through the sharing of the body of Christ

**Gospel: John 6:51-58** Leading up to the passage of today's Gospel reading John 6, Jesus has evoked the imagery of manna provided to the Jewish ancestors in the desert. Like that provision, Jesus is a gift from God, given freely to satisfy the needs of many in ways that go beyond any blessing that has come before. Jesus is the 'living bread from heaven'.


