# Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time - 27th August 2023

Dear Parishioners.

"Who do people say the Son of Man is?" Today, like the disciples in 1<sup>st</sup> century Palestine, we have our different answers. However, dear parishioner, "who do you say Jesus is?" It was Peter's answer to this second question that established the context of the Petrine authority as



"You are Peter and on this rock I will build my Church." When we engage in a kind of conversation in spirit, our first answer may just be a lead up to new and inspired answers. The responses of the other disciples were correct in their own right—but Peter's was inspired not by flesh and blood.

The Australian Catholic Bishops Conference since 1940 has continued to release Social Justice Statements in order for the Australian Catholic community to reflect and act on our social, economic and ecological situations in the light of the Gospel. This Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> August, is the 2023 Social Justice Sunday. The title of the Social Justice Statement 2023-24 is Listen, Learn, Love: A new engagement with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples. I was at St James Coorparoo on Wednesday 23rd August during the Launch of this year's statement. The statement was launched with guest speakers Bishop Tim Norton and Brother Damien Price. My take away from the launch is to always listen, learn and love even when I have a lot to say. The Social Justice Sunday Statement which is available at <a href="https://bit.ly/SJS2023-24">https://bit.ly/SJS2023-24</a> calls us to respectfully and actively engage in dialogues, sharing information and listening to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people about the proposed Voice to Parliament.

To all our new parishioners and their families, we welcome you to our community and hope that you will grow our community with the treasures that you bring to us. At the New Parishioners BBQ Lunch this Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> August, some of us will be available to share our experiences with you and you are most welcome to tell us how you feel among us. As we welcome our new parishioners, I feel it is also an opportunity for all of us to consider our participation in the parish especially in the many Popular Piety Groups, Social Groups, Faith Formation Groups, Youth and Children Groups, Prayer, Music and Liturgy Groups. I would like to invite everyone to participate in some of the parish events happening next week. The First Friday in September will be a day we celebrate Anointing Mass and pray for all the sick and those who care for them. There will be a morning tea in the Paloma Centre after Mass. There will be a special Fathers Day Men's Breakfast on Saturday 2 September. Details on page 2 of this newsletter.

**Next Sunday is Father's day**. Will be celebrating our fathers with **special Mass intentions and celebratory Cuppa after all our Weekend Masses**. Let us make this year's Father's Day very special for our parish men.

# II. DIALOGUE FOR NEW NATIONAL AND LOCAL POLICIES

177. Given the real potential for a misuse of human abilities, individual states can no longer ignore their responsibility for planning, coordination, oversight and enforcement within their respective borders. How can a society plan and protect its future amid constantly developing technological innovations? One authoritative source of oversight and coordination is the law, which lays down rules for admissible conduct in the light of the common good. The limits which a healthy, mature and sovereign society must impose are those related to foresight and security, regulatory norms, timely enforcement, the elimination of corruption, effective responses to undesired side-effects of production processes, and appropriate intervention where potential or uncertain risks are involved. There is a growing jurisprudence dealing with the reduction of pollution by business activities. But political and institutional frameworks do not exist simply to avoid bad practice, but also to promote best practice, to stimulate creativity in seeking new solutions and to encourage individual or group initiative.


