### 26th Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year A)

**First Reading: Ezekiel 18:25-28** The way of righteousness is life, the way of wickedness is death. However, these ways are not set in stone; the one who is righteous can turn to away from it and, similarly, the sinful one always has a path to righteousness and life along with it.

**Second Reading: Philippians 2:1-11** Christ emptied himself of all privilege and power of being equal with God, humbled himself to be with us as sinners even to the point of death. Raised by God, we can follow Christ's example in shunning vain ambition and, through humility, find the glory of God.

**Gospel: Matthew 21:28-32** A landowner needing work done is again used as a parable on the nature of the kingdom. Matthew presents us contrasting figures; one who says the right things but whose words have no substance, and one who outwardly seems outside the will of the landowner, but ultimately is the righteous one.






