Well done to all in our leadership and administrative team.

There have been discussions on whether we need all the ministries, all the Liturgies and all the weekend Masses that we offer here in the Parish. These discussions will lead to consultations and survey in the 1st half of 2024 before any pastoral decision is taken. Hence, I call on every parishioner to pray for our community, consider what you can do and how you can support our Parish ministries in 2024 and beyond.

I will be taking my annual leave after Christmas and will be visiting my family and friends in Nigeria. I will miss you but will keep you in my thoughts and prayers. Fr Francis Arackal OP will be assisting Fr Francisco and the Parish staff in ministering to all your pastoral needs in my absence. Fr Francis Arackal is a Dominican priest who believes that the Media provides News (information) but the Bible provides Good News (words of eternal life). I hope that his reflections during his short stay with us will help us to balance the many news on the media with the Good News in the Bible. Welcome Fr Francis and enjoy your stay in our lovely parish.
