### Our Lady of Lourdes Feast Day - Sunday 11th February 2024

Dear Parishioners.

I am delighted to be back to our community and thank you for giving me the opportunity for a wonderful holiday. One thing that I so much appreciated during my holiday is the biblical meaning of Genesis 2:2 "God rested on the 7th day". The Scripture presents a great good news in the Creation story when the Omnipotent Creator had time to rest. The time of rest



is the crown of God's Creation and this has myriad of meanings in all spheres of our spiritual, religious, social, and material life. Although I have a lot of dreams and imaginations for you and our community this year, I would like to wish you an enriched experience of rest even in the midst of your daily work.

This weekend is very special for us as we celebrate the feast of Our Lady of Lourdes. **We joyfully welcome Bishop Tim Norton SVD** who will be joining us this weekend to celebrate our parish feast day. **The feast of Our Lady of Lourdes reminds us of Mary the mother of Jesus and the patron of our parish**. Whenever we celebrate our parish feast day, we acknowledge the history of God's grace working through our Priests and Parishioners in the past, present and future of the Sunnybank Parish. It is a celebration of the Catholic Faith planted here as a mustard seed in 1955 and still being nurtured in 2024. **Happy feast day to all of us and please stay back after each of this weekend Masses for a celebrative Cuppa tea and to say hello to some new parishioners**.

Each year, this feast somehow sets the tone for our parish life. On Thursday 8th February, our primary school officially started the 2024 School Year with a beautiful Opening School Mass dedicated to Our Lady of Lourdes. At Lourdes, the Blessed Virgin Mary instructed Bernadette Soubirous to "dig in the ground nearby, from which came a spring with healing properties." For us here in the Sunnybank community today, if we dare to dig around us, what will we find? Do we even have the faith to try? St Bernadette trusted the message of Our Lady and generations of pilgrims found solace in the spring she dug. May we be inspired to dig around our community to create oasis of peace, joy and healing for the world around us. Ours is to put our faith into action even in face of fear and uncertainty.

Things come around so quickly and time they say waits for nobody. Just a few weeks after Christmas, Lent begins on **Ash Wednesday, 14th February 2024**. The Church life will assume a Lenten disposition and we are called to join. During this season, the Church retreats and we are supposed to participate in this retreat. This year, **Fr Francis Arackal OP will be leading our Parish Mission Retreat** from the weekend of 17th and 18th February to Wednesday 21st February. **I would like to invite you, your family and friends to pray and participate especially in the retreat sessions in the mornings or evenings of 19th, 20th and 21st February.** 

On a pastoral and liturgical note, Lent is a season of Prayer, Self-denial and Charity. These religious acts help both the individual and the whole church to prepare for Easter. I encourage you to take a personal advantage of some of our common prayer opportunities like; Daily Masses, Tuesday Evening Adoration, Wednesday Rosary after Mass, Thursday Christian Meditation before Mass, Friday Eucharistic Adoration and Benediction after Mass, and Stations of the Cross. The Caritas Australia's Project: Compassion is a veritable means of doing charity during Lent. Envelopes and boxes will be available for your alms giving and donations.


