Second Sunday of Lent - Sunday 25th February 2024

Dear Parishioners,

On this 2nd Sunday of Lent and while meditating on the 1st reading from the book of Genesis 22: 1-18, I feel honoured and humbled to be your parish Priest. When I joined you on 1st January 2019, I had just my story to share but today your story is my story. I started as a 2nd Associate Pastor, then the 1st

This parish was so alive and vibrant, a community to belong and a parish with lots of opportunities for prayer and spirituality. At the beginning of 2020, the world changed and our parish was affected. Our parish life and ministry was disrupted and we struggled to get back on track.

Our resilience and openness to hear and see where God is leading our community has been my source of encouragement. I am honestly humbled by the generosity of many old and new parishioners who have taken part in multiple ministries to restore the vibrancy of our parish. I understand and would like to affirm the sacrifices that we make for our parish on this 2024 Ministry Sunday.

Our annual Ministry Sunday is a day that we set apart to acknowledge and affirm the variety and richness of the ministries in our Parish. This weekend we thank God who has called us to different ministries and services within and outside our parish. We pray that God may continue to nurture in us the variety of gifts for the building up of the Church.

The reason I began this message by telling my story is to encourage those parishioners who feel new or having little to offer in the life of the parish. My story in this parish like Abraham in Genesis 22: 1-18, has a little beginning. In Genesis 22:1-18, God spoke to Abraham 3 times; "Take your son ... offer him as a burnt offering", "Abraham, Abraham, do not raise your hand against the boy" and lastly, "I swear by my own self, I will shower blessings on you". In our journey of faith, God keeps leading us and I pray that we keep responding to God's call. The 2024 Ministry Sunday Forms will be available in the Church and on our Parish website. The form is for everyone to commit or recommit to the ministries where you have something to offer. You are called to consider volunteering in one or two ministries. We will organise Training and Induction sessions for all volunteers once we collate the completed ministry forms.

Next weekend we will welcome the children and their families who will be enrolling into the Sacramental Program for Reconciliation. These children have completed their Sacraments of Initiation and are now invited to embrace the mercy of God in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Their enrolment this time of Lent is also a reminder for us to consider going to Confession during this Lent.

Just a friendly reminder that the parking at the front of the Church on weekends, is especially reserved for the elderly the handicapped, and those with small children. Please consider these people and perhaps use the grass carpark near the train station.



SUNNYBANK SOCIAL JUSTICE COMMUNITY

In his Christmas Day "Urbi et Orbi" address, Pope Francis said that Israel's bombardment of Gaza is reaping an "appalling harvest" of innocent civilians. He also called the October 7 attack on Israel by Hamas "abominable" as he appealed for an end to hostilities.

The Vatican, which has diplomatic relations with both Israel and the Palestinian Authorities, believes a two-state solution is the only answer to the long-running conflict. Francis called for "persevering dialogue between the parties, sustained by strong political will and the support of the international community".

The monthly community meeting will be held in ARMIA House, Mains Road, opposite the church on Thursday 29th February commencing at 7pm. All are invited to join the discussion and to plan activities for 2024.
