### Palm Sunday of the Passion - Sunday 24th March 2024

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

### Welcome to the Holy Week!

It is with a good sense of excitement that I welcome the many people of God who will flock around our church during these days of holy celebrations. I feel that holiness attracts, and that is the reason the Holy Week is always the most attended week of liturgical celebrations in the church. To those who come occasionally, good to see you again and to those who are fairly regular, I hope you will be as excited as I am. We have witnessed an increased number of volunteers willing to assist in making our Holy Week ceremonies beautiful.

Thank you to those parishioners who joined the Chrism Mass ceremony on Thursday in solidarity with the Archbishop, Clergy and the entire faithful. While our priests and deacons have renewed their commitment to be stewards of the sacred mysteries and mission of the church, the people of God has promised to offer their prayerful support to us. In the Chrism Mass, 3 oils were blessed and consecrated for the spiritual and temporal good of the people of God. The Oil of the Sick was blessed for the safeguard of our body, soul, and spirit from all pains, all infirmity and all sickness. The Oil of Catechumens was blessed for the strengthening of the faith of new members of the church. The Oil of Holy Chrism was consecrated for the anointing of the people of God as prophets, priests, kings, and martyrs. A portion of each of these oils will be kept in our sanctuary for the wellbeing of our parishioners.

Our 2024 RCIA candidates will be the first to be anointed with these oils as a sign of our welcome and the freshness of their faith. The Holy Week will be a grace-filled week for these brothers and sisters of ours. They will be among those whose feet will be washed on Holy Thursday, they will bring the Bread and Wine for the Easter Vigil Mass, and they will receive Baptism and Confirmation within the Easter Vigil Mass. It is our prayers that these festivities will nourish and sustain their faith.

The Alpha Course has been a great agency for both cradle Catholics and not so church people in exploring the meaning of faith in our contemporary world. The program has been running for the past 6 year here and the stories of past participants is always heart-warming. I would like to invite you to do any or all of the following; pray for the success of the program, tell someone about it, register, and join the next session. Palm Sunday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter are wonderful opportunities to promote our faith formation programs in our families and among our friends.

During our Easter Vigil service of light this year, we encourage parishioners to come with electric power candles instead of wax candles. This will help us minimise our use of carbon as well as reduce the hazard of flame candles. Only the Paschal Candle and the Altar Candles will be of wax and flame. May we join the Palm Sunday Procession that will lead us to the Easter Vigil Procession that will be bring us to the glorious light of Easter.

**First Reading: Isaiah 50:4-7** Filled with the spirit of the Lord, the disciple's ear is opened, and tongue loosened to hear and speak God's word. Isaiah sets his face like flint against his oppressors.

**Second Reading: Philippians 2:6-11** Despite his equality with God, Jesus Christ emptied himself in humility to give himself completely in his humanity. For this, God raised him above all others, and gave him the name above all other names.

**Gospel: Mark 14:1—15:47** The Passion of Jesus Christ, the most well-known story of Christian faith. Mark begins his account in the house of Simon the Leper and leaves us at the tomb of the Lord where the entrance is secured with a stone.




### **EASTER VIGIL CELEBRATION**

At the Easter Vigil, 8 new members of our faith community will be receiving the Sacraments of Initiation after journeying through the RCIA program. Elizabeth,




Destiny, Janaka, Edwina and Anton will be baptised. and Ron, Jeni and Manuel will be confirmed.
