# Pentecost Sunday - 19th May 2024

Dear Parishioners,

Happy Pentecost! With the celebration of the descent of the Holy Spirit on the early disciples of Jesus, we conclude the Easter Season. Also, with the celebration of the birth or rather the official inauguration of the church, we are ushered into the second half of ordinary time of the liturgical year which will lead us to the next Advent Season. This year, s



liturgical year which will lead us to the next Advent Season. This year, something about the story of the Pentecost as recorded in the Acts of the Apostles, makes more sense to me than the rest. While we have always focused on the effect of the Pentecost on the disciples of Jesus, we rarely reflect on the fact that "There were devout Jews from every nation under heaven staying in Jerusalem" on the day of Pentecost. These were attracted to the scene of the disciples' Pentecost experience. They too, contributed to the Pentecost narrative and were among the three thousand that were added to the number of believers. As we acknowledge and celebrate the workings of the Holy Spirit in the Church, let us be open to the reality of the power of the Holy Spirit working even beyond the institutional church.

I thank God for the wonderful experience I had during my retreat last week at the Santa Teresa. Santa Teresa Spirituality Centre has an aura suited for retreat and the staff looked after us very well. I had the opportunity to meditate on God's Love manifested in Christ' Love for the world. I realized that I am specially loved by God, by the church, by my family and friends. Imagine with me, the love of God in my Baptism freely given and received in the Church. Think of the love of God in my Confirmation where the Spirit of God is poured into my heart and for the building up of the Church. Appreciate the generous love of God in the Holy Eucharist, the Mercy received in the sacrament of Reconciliation and the strength given through the sacrament of Anointing. I feel beloved to have been called, chosen and ordained to be a minister of God's love in the world. I just hope that my life and ministry will communicate God's love to others even as we build a parish community of love.

Next week will be very significant in the life of our parish. In the hierarchy of the church as the body of Christ, the gathering of the faithful for the celebration of the Eucharist on Sundays is higher than the reconstruction of the church building where they gather. Hence, the Sunday Mass for us Catholics is a religious obligation despite the place and time of the celebration. I am very conscious of the effect the change of our Mass times will cause us and hope that it will enrich our Eucharistic assembly. Thank you for your prayers, patience and participation during the time of consultation and listening to our suggestions. I will not keep you waiting any further than next weekend before announcing the new Sunday Mass Times. We will have the whole of June to logistically adjust and transit to the New Mass Times which will be implemented on the weekend of 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> July 2024.

We congratulate and pray for Archbishop Mark Coleridge on the Golden Jubilee of his priestly ordination. We welcome the parents of the children joining our 2024 Sacramental program to their children's rites of enrolment next weekend. We thank those who have submitted the Parish Pastoral Council nomination form to me or Fr Francisco. May the Holy Spirit come, kindle and renew in us the fire of his love to the glory of God.




