## The Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ - 2nd June 2024

Dear Parishioners,

Today the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, also called Corpus Christi. **It is an opportunity to reflect on the mystery of the Eucharist and consider its various benefits in the life of the Church.** This solemnity invites us to manifest our faith and devotion to this Most Holy Sacrament.



**The Solemnity promotes the awareness that the Holy Eucharist is the Sacrament of Body and Blood of Jesus received in the appearance of the bread and wine.** The Solemnity of Corpus Christi is the feast that exalts our faith in the real presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist and in the Church. The Eucharist builds the Church as well as the community that shares in it.

The Sacrament of the Eucharist has many evocations: it is a memorial of the Passion of the Lord, it is a Banquet of unity, it is an anticipation of the divine life that we will share with Christ in Heaven, and the source and summit of our Christian life. Therefore, **it is necessary for us to remember and proclaim what we celebrate, hence the memorial acclamation of "when we eat this bread and drink this cup we proclaim your death o Lord, until you come again"**. We should become like Jesus in whom we have Communion.

Furthermore, the Eucharist is a gift from God that teaches us that "man does not only live on human bread but on everything that comes from the mouth of God". The Eucharist assures us of the Lord's special help in crossing the desert of life until reaching the eternal banquet. Eating the flesh of the Lord and drinking his blood is to dwell in Him and He in us.

**The Eucharistic devotion has two dimensions: its celebration, which is the mass, and its preservation in the tabernacle for the sick, and adoration.** The main devotion to the Eucharist is its celebration and communion as a memorial of Jesus Christ, and this is properly the Holy Mass.

**The Corpus Christi Procession is part of this Solemnity and it is our public witness and veneration of the Holy Eucharist in order to become in some form, bread broken and wine shared for our brothers and sisters who are our companions on the journey.** We are people who must let ourselves be transformed. May the Lord Jesus, made visible by the heavenly gift of the Eucharist, bless our families and our parish.

By "bringing a plate" for the celebration after mass. We ask that:

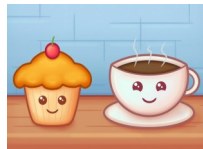
- **No Hot Food** as we will be unable to warm food that day

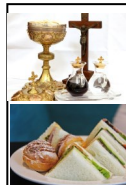
**Hands:** Make a conscious effort to choose more sustainable options in your life, shrink your carbo impact and pollution in big and small ways

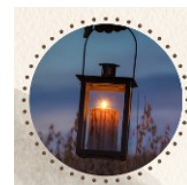

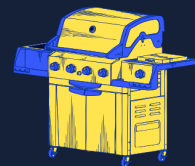

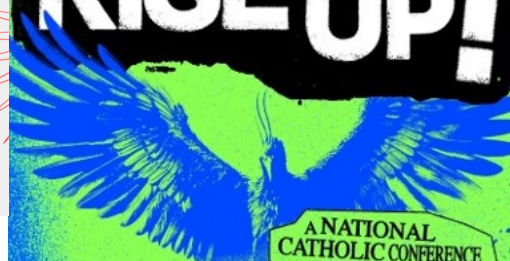
